After a rash of cottage break-ins in South Portage, Baysville and on Menominee Lake, OPP has arrested six suspects. The B&E's over the last couple of months has resulted in theft of property and also a great deal of vandalism to the cottages. The six all face an assortment of charges including break and enter, mischief over \$5,000, possession of stolen property and breach of bail conditions. 19-year old Corey Lavoie, 21-year old Matthew Mcindoo and 21-year old Justin Butler, all of Huntsville, and three Young Offenders will be in court at a later date to answer to the charges. None of the six are suspected in the ongoing home invasion investigation.
