THE PURPOSE of the application will be to consider a proposed 30 metre monopine (tree-type) telecommunications towers located within the Township of Lake of Bays pursuant to its Policy for Establishing Telecommunication Facilities.

EXPLANATION OF THE PURPOSE AND EFFECT OF THE PROPOSAL:

Applications have been received from Rogers Communications Inc. to locate two 30 metre monopine telecommunication towers on each of the following private properties:

CT 01/14 LOB – Part of Lot 25, Concession 13, Ridout Ward, at 1028 Old Highway 117 (Roll No. 030-011-14202), as shown on the location map.

CT 02/14 LOB – Part of Lot 24, Concession 4, Franklin Ward, at Point Ideal Road (Vacant land) (Roll No. 010-017-00305), as shown on the location map.


